Application Guidelines

Mifflin County COVID-19 Relief

Non-Profit Assistance Grant Program

The application window will open October 29, 2020.

You will have 10 business days to complete the application before the window closes at EOB on November 12, 2020.

The following website (www.restoremifflincounty.com) will be the primary location for information (guidelines & application) and making application. This is not a first-come, first-served program.

Program Eligibility:

To be eligible to apply, an entity <u>must</u> meet all six of the eligibility requirements:

- ➤ Grants are available up to \$35,000 for non-profit organizations that have been negatively affected by the COVID-19 pandemic and related statewide closures. Funding tiers are listed below.
- ➤ Grants are available <u>only</u> for entities with annual revenues (prior to March 1, 2020) of \$1.5 million or less <u>and</u> have 50 or fewer full-time employees (FTEs). A part-time employee equals a .5 full-time employee. Revenues are based on the IRS tax Form-990 filing information, as well as internally generated financial statements.
- > Entity must be based in and operate primarily in Mifflin County, Pennsylvania.
- ➤ Entity must fall under one of the following IRS designations: 501 © (3) or 501 © (19).
- ➤ Entity must have been in operation for, at least, one year prior to February 15, 2020.
- ➤ Entities must currently be operating or have a clear plan to re-open once the Commonwealth permits re-opening.

Program Priorities:

Primary Priority will be given to:

- Entities who have <u>not</u> received advances or forgivable loans through the following programs: US SBA Paycheck Protection Program/PPP; US SBA Economic Injury Disaster Loan/EIDL Program.
- Entities impacted the most financially, taking into consideration gross revenue losses and documentable expenses, especially from canceled or postponed fundraising activities.

Grant Funding Structure:

Only one grant per entity allowed.

Relief Program	Annual Revenue	Amount Available Per Entity (up to)
Grant:	Revenue up to \$50,000	\$5,000 grant
Grant:	Revenue from \$50,001 – \$75,000	\$10,000 grant
Grant:	Revenue from \$75,001 – \$100,000	\$15,000 grant
Grant:	Revenue from \$100,001 -\$250,000	\$20,000 grant

Grant:	Revenue from \$250,001 -\$500,000	\$25,000 grant
Grant:	Revenue from \$500,001 – \$1,500,000	\$35,000 grant

Eligible Use of Funds:

- ➤ Documentable payroll and associated costs, costs related to the continuation of group health care benefits during periods of paid sick, medical, or family leave, and insurance premiums, payable for the period covering March 1 through August 31, 2020.
- Documentable rent, utility payments, business insurance, and other eligible overhead expenses payable for the period covering March 1 through August 31, 2020.
- ➤ Documentable working capital expenses incurred for the purpose of re-opening operations after being fully or partially closed due to the state-mandated business closure period commencing March 1, 2020, as long as the expense was incurred due to COVID-19.
- Documentable expenses incurred related to implementing COVID-19 mitigation plans, including but not limited to specialized equipment, barriers, personal protective equipment and employee training expense to ensure compliance with state and federal CDC guidelines for reopening.
- Documented Covid-19 mitigation related expenses (as detailed above) <u>NOT</u> already paid for with other relief measures such as federal advances or forgivable loans through the US SBA PPP or EIDL.

Ineligible Entities:

> Entities that are not physically based in Mifflin County, Pennsylvania.

- > Entities engaged in any activity that is illegal under federal, state, or local law.
- ➤ Entities that have ever obtained a direct or guaranteed loan from through a federal and/or state agency that is currently delinquent or has defaulted within the last seven years and caused a loss to the government.
- Private clubs and entities which limit the number of memberships for reasons other than capacity.
- Entities engaged in political or lobbying activities.

Get Prepared:

Required Documentation and Information from Applicants (items provided in preferably electronic format for upload, such as a PDF)

- ➤ A short narrative describing how the Covid-19 Pandemic has affected your organization as it has attempted to pursue its mission. Please detail particular losses of revenue and how it has affected your ability to maintain operating overhead.
- Copies of:

Most recently filed (2018 or 2019) IRS Form 990, with all schedules.
If not the 2019 990, internally generated 2019 financial statements (Balance Sheet-B/S & Income-Expense Statement-I/E).
Current financial statements (B/S & I/E) for the organization.
Internal financial statements (I/E) from March 1 - May 31, 2019.
Internal financial statements (I/E) from March 1 - May 31, 2020.
Schedule of all expenses incurred, for the period March 1 through August 31, 2020, to accommodate/endure the conditions and mitigation required due to the Covid-19 Pandemic, for which you wish to receive these grant funds.

____ Copies of all invoices, receipts, canceled checks and other proving documents such as bank statements and credit card statements (listed in aggregate on the above schedule), for which you wish to receive these grant funds.

- Copy of official filing with PA Department of State or local municipality for your entity such as: (one of the following)
 - Articles of Incorporation
 - Certificate of Organization
 - Fictitious Name registration
 - IRS determination letter
- > Any form of acceptable government-issued photo ID of the CEO
- > List of names of the board and officers
